How to Manage an Accident

- 1. Call 911 for Police or an ambulance if needed. (In most states, if there is no bodily injury, you are to remove the vehicles from the road.)
- 2. Fill out the Accident Log Sheet and provide your insurance information to the other driver. FYI It is typically the insurance companies or attorneys that determines who is at fault so you don't have to readily have someone admit who was at fault.
- 3. Call their insurance company <u>at the scene</u>, if possible, to verify they do have coverage and that it hasn't lapsed.
- 4. Call <u>your own tow company</u>. If the tow company that shows up says they have to tow your vehicle to their lot refuse the tow. DO NOT ALLOW THEM TO TOW YOUR VEHICLE TO THEIR HOLDING LOT AS THERE WILL BE ADDITIONAL CHARGES.

We recommend you have your vehicle towed to a

- * Body Shop
- * Repair Shop
- * Your home
- not to the police impound lot as you will be charged for this.
- 5. Take pictures with a camera or your phone from all different angles. They may come in handy later as we all tend to forget things in stressful situations. Insurance companies like looking at them too.
- 6. Move your vehicle if it may cause other drivers to have an accident. Otherwise, do not move your vehicle until a law enforcement officer tells you to.
- 7. If you hit an unattended vehicle, you must make an effort to find the owner or driver. If you are unable to locate the owner of an unattended vehicle, you are required to leave a note indicating your name and contact information, and a brief description of the accident.
- 8. <u>If you are out of town</u> and don't know who to contact if there is one, call the local AAA Office. Have them recommend a tow company and body or repair shop. AAA is usually a very good source for recommendations even if you are not a member.
